Getting Here (Gilmorehill Campus)

By Road

[View](#)

- The University of Glasgow Gilmorehill Campus is located to the west of Glasgow city centre. From Carlisle, Newcastle and the south, exit M74 on to the M73, joining the M8 at the Old Monkland junction. M8 exits for the University are J18 if travelling from the south, Edinburgh and the north and J19 if coming from Glasgow Airport and the west. Other main routes serving the University include Great Western Road (A82, north of campus), Clydeside Expressway (A814, south) and Byres Road (B808, west).
- Car parking at the University Campuses is limited and a Vehicle Management and Enforcement Scheme is in operation. There is limited pay and display on street parking across the campus and a long stay pay and display public car park in Lilybank Gardens. There are designated bays for disabled staff, students and visitors across the campus car parks. By Bus

- Buchanan bus station is the main bus terminus in Glasgow for inter city coach services. First Group buses Simplicity services 4 and 4A , bus routes 15 and 370 and Stagecoach bus services X25, X25A, X76 and X77 all stop on University Avenue by the Main Gate opposite the library.

By Train

View

- The nearest train station to the University is Partick to the west of the campus approximately 0.9 miles away (18 minutes) via Byres Road. There is step free access throughout the station via lifts and ramp access for trains. There is an induction loop at the booking office.
The nearest train station to the east of the University campus is Charing Cross approximately 0.9 miles away (19 minutes) from Bank Street via Woodlands Road. There is step free access throughout the station via lifts and ramp access for trains. There is an induction loop at the booking office.

By Underground

View

- The nearest underground station is Hillhead on Byres Road. The station has stepped and escalator access to platforms only. The nearest underground station to the east of the campus is Kelvinbridge, the station has stepped and escalator access to platforms only.

View

- This information is for the entrance located at the front of the building.
- There is ramped/sloped or stepped access at this entrance.
- There is not a bell/buzzer.
- There is not an intercom.
- There is a canopy or recess which provides weather protection at this entrance.
- The main door(s) open(s) automatically.
- The door(s) is / are double.
- The width of the door opening is 145cm (4ft 9in).
- There is a small lip on the threshold of the entrance, with a height of less than 2cm.

Second Set of Doors

View

- There is a second set of doors.
- The door(s) open(s) automatically.
- The door(s) is / are double.
- The width of the door opening is 145cm (4ft 9in).
- There is a small lip on the threshold of the entrance, with a height of less than 2cm.

Ramp/Slope

View

- There is a ramp/slope at this entrance.
- The ramp/slope is located in front of the entrance on the right.
- The ramp/slope does bypass the step(s).
- The ramp/slope gradient is steep.
- The ramp is permanent.
- There is not a level landing at the top of the ramp.
- The ramp does have handrails.
- The handrails are on the left going up the ramp.
- The width of the ramp is 135cm (4ft 5in).

Step(s)

View

- There is a / are step(s) at this entrance.
- The step(s) is / are located in front of the entrance.
- There is / are 11 step(s) to access the entrance.
- There is not tactile paving at the top and bottom of the step(s).
- The step(s) is / are clearly marked.
- The step(s) is / are medium height (11cm - 17cm).

- The steps do have handrails.
- The handrails are on both sides.



- The desk is 5m (5yd 1ft) from the main entrance.
- The reception area is clearly visible from the entrance.
- There is step free access to this reception area.
- The lighting levels in the reception area are moderate to good.
- The reception desk/counter is high (110cm+).
- There is not a low section of the counter (76cm or below) available.
- The desk is staffed.
- There is not a hearing assistance system.

- The steps have a handrail on both sides.
- There is a landing.

- There is a lift for public use.
- The lift is located ahead as you enter.
- The lift is a standard lift.
- The floors which are accessible by this lift are G, 1, 2 and 3.
- Wall mounted information boards are not provided at lift landings.
- The lift is approximately 5m (5yd 1ft) from the main entrance.
- Staff do not need to be notified for use of the lift.
- The clear door width is 80cm (2ft 7in).
- The dimensions of the lift are 127cm x 130cm (4ft 2in x 4ft 3in).
- There are not separate entry and exit doors in the lift.
- There is a mirror to aid reversing out of the lift.

- The lift does have a visual floor indicator.
- The lift does not have an audible announcer.
- The lift has a hearing enhancement system.
- The lift does have tactile markings.
- The controls for the lift are within 90cm - 120cm from the floor.
- The lighting level in the lift is good.

Theatre (The Venue)

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- There are designated spaces for wheelchair users.
 - Designated seating is located in the second row of the balcony.
 - Wheelchairs are left with you.
 - A companion may sit with you.
 - Companions sit behind you.
 - It is 35m (38yd 10in) from the designated seating area to the nearest accessible toilet.
 - This venue does not provide audio described performances.
 - There is not a hearing assistance system.
 - There is not a wheelchair to borrow.
 - Concessions are not available.
 - Assistance dogs are allowed in the auditorium.

View

- Access to the designated seating is via the main lift and through the Bar.
- Access to the accessible toilet facilities is via lift to the ground floor.
- There is a raised standing area on the ground floor with 3 marked steps to each end without handrails.



- The lighting levels are adjustable.
- Lighting levels can be adjusted by a member of staff upon request.
- Lighting levels may be lower in the evening.
- Access to the additional seating area is via 3 unmarked medium steps with handrails to both sides.
- There is a single marked medium step to access booth tables. There is a raised seating / stage area.

- There is some flooring which includes patterns or colours which could be confusing or look like steps or holes to some people.
- The lighting levels are moderate to good.
- Lighting levels can be adjusted by a member of staff upon request.
- Lighting levels may be lower in the evening.

- The restaurant/bar is located on Level 2, to the left from the lift.
- There is step-free access, via lift, to the restaurant/bar.

- Menu types include; online menus and large print menus.
- Menus are clearly written.
- Menus are presented in contrasting colours.

- Adapted cutlery is not available.
- Drinking straws are available.
- This area does play background music.



Location of Toilet/Changing Facilities

- Accessible toilet facilities are located on the ground floor within the male and female standard toilets.
- Female and male standard toilet facilities are located on the ground floor to the right as you enter outside the VENUE and on the first floor within the BAR..
- Gender Neutral standard toilet facilities are located on the third floor to the left as you exit the lift..

Standard Shower (Gender Neutral Toilets)

- Shower facilities are available.
- The shower(s) surveyed is/are located on Level 3, to the left from the lift.
- There is not level access to the services from the shower facilities.

Comments

View

- There is a medium height unmarked step without handrails to access the showers.

Toilet with Adaptations (Male - Right Hand Transfer)

Location and Access

View

- This accessible toilet is located within the male standard toilet, ahead and to the right as you enter the main entrance.
- This accessible toilet is approximately 20m (21yd 2ft) from the main entrance.
- There is step-free access into the accessible toilet.
- This is a male toilet.
- A key is required for the accessible toilet.
- The key is a radar key.
- The key can be obtained from reception.
- There is pictorial signage on or near the toilet door.
- The visual contrast between the external door and wall is high.
- The door opens outwards.
- The door is easy to open.
- The door is locked by a locking handle.
- The width of the accessible toilet opening is 76cm (2ft 6in).
- The contrast between the internal door and wall is high.
- The door has a horizontal grab rail.
- The contrast between the horizontal grab rail and internal door is high.

Toilet Features

View

- The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 132cm x 143cm (4ft 4in x 4ft 8in).
- The accessible toilet does not have an unobstructed minimum turning space of 150cm x 150cm.
- The lighting levels are good.
- There is a lateral transfer space.
- As you face the toilet pan the transfer space is on the right.
- The lateral transfer space is 75cm (2ft 6in).
- There is a flush on the transfer side.
- There is not a spatula type lever flush.
- There is a lever flush.
- There is a dropdown rail on the transfer side.
- The contrast between the dropdown rail(s) and wall is high.
- There is a/are wall-mounted grab rail(s) available.
- As you face the toilet the wall-mounted grab rail(s) is/are on both sides.
- There is a vertical wall-mounted grab rail on the transfer side.
- There is a horizontal wall-mounted grab rail on the opposite side of the seat to the transfer space.
- The visual contrast between the wall-mounted grab rail(s) and wall is high.
- The contrast between the walls and floor is high.
- There is not an emergency alarm.
- There is not a red flashing fire alarm beacon within the toilet.
- Disposal facilities are not available in the toilet.
- There is not a/are not coat hook(s).


Additional Fixtures

View

- There is not a mirror.
- There is not a shelf within the accessible toilet.
- The toilet has a backrest and a cistern.
- The height of the toilet seat above floor level is 40cm (1ft 4in).
- The toilet seat visual contrast is low.
- There is a toilet roll holder.
- The toilet roll holder can be reached from seated on the toilet.
- The toilet roll holder is placed higher than 100cm (3ft 3in).
- The height of the toilet roll holder is 107cm (3ft 6in).
- The visual contrast between the toilet roll holder and the wall is low.
- There is a wash basin.
- The wash basin and tap(s) can be reached from seated on the toilet.
- The wash basin is not placed higher than 74cm (2ft 5in).
- There is a vertical wall-mounted grab rail on the right hand side of the wash basin.
- The visual contrast between the wash basin wall-mounted grab rail(s) and wall is high.
- The wash basin tap type is lever mixer.
- There is not a wall fixed soap dispenser.
- There is a handheld soap dispenser available.
- There is not a towel dispenser.
- There is not a hand dryer.

Toilet with Adaptations (Female - Right Hand Transfer)

Location and Access

View

- This accessible toilet is located within the female standard toilets, ahead and to the right as you enter the main entrance.
- This accessible toilet is approximately 30m (32yd 2ft) from the main entrance.
- There is step-free access into the accessible toilet.
- This is a female toilet.
- A key is required for the accessible toilet.
- The key is a radar key.
- The key can be obtained from reception.
- There is no signage on or near the toilet door.
- The visual contrast between the external door and wall is low.
- The door opens inwards.
- The door is easy to open.

- The door is locked by a locking handle.
- The width of the accessible toilet opening is 75cm (2ft 6in).
- The contrast between the internal door and wall is medium.
- The door does not have a horizontal grab rail.

- The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 128cm x 258cm (4ft 2in x 8ft 6in).
- The accessible toilet does not have an unobstructed minimum turning space of 150cm x 150cm.
- The lighting levels are moderate to good.
- There is a lateral transfer space.
- As you face the toilet pan the transfer space is on the right.
- The lateral transfer space is 74cm (2ft 5in).
- The transfer space is obstructed by a sanitary bin.
- There is a flush on the transfer side.
- There is not a spatula type lever flush.
- There is a lever flush.
- There is a dropdown rail on the transfer side.
- The contrast between the dropdown rail(s) and wall is high.
- There is a/are wall-mounted grab rail(s) available.
- As you face the toilet the wall-mounted grab rail(s) is/are on both sides.
- There is a vertical wall-mounted grab rail on the transfer side.
- There is a horizontal wall-mounted grab rail on the opposite side of the seat to the transfer space.
- The visual contrast between the wall-mounted grab rail(s) and wall is high.
- The contrast between the walls and floor is high.
- There is not an emergency alarm.
- There is not a red flashing fire alarm beacon within the toilet.
- Disposal facilities are available in the toilet.
- There is a/are sanitary disposal units.
- There is not a/are not coat hook(s).



- The toilet has a backrest and a cistern.
- The height of the toilet seat above floor level is 44cm (1ft 5in).
- The toilet seat visual contrast is low.
- There is a toilet roll holder.
- The toilet roll holder can be reached from seated on the toilet.
- The toilet roll holder is not placed higher than 100cm (3ft 3in).
- The visual contrast between the toilet roll holder and the wall is medium.
- There is a wash basin.

- The wash basin is placed higher than 74cm (2ft 5in).
- The height of the wash basin is 82cm (2ft 8in).

- The wash basin tap type is lever mixer.
- There is not a wall fixed soap dispenser.
- There is a towel dispenser.
- The towel dispenser can be reached from seated on the toilet.
- The towel dispenser is placed higher than 100cm (3ft 3in).
- The height of the towel dispenser is 105cm.
- The visual contrast between the towel dispenser and the wall is medium.
- There is not a hand dryer.
